Community Partners; attached are the Central Patrol Division Crime Maps for 12-06 to 12-19-09. Also a few last minute crime tips for our Holiday Season.

1- Never leave gifts in your car, even covered with a blanket or coat, the thief knows something is under there and worth breaking into. This time of year criminals will break into vehicles hoping that diamond ring or other jewelry is being stored in the glovebox. Leave items in lawaway until the last minute or leave with a trusted friend/family.

2- Never place presents under the Christmas tree that can be seen through a window. Use decorative paper to cover the lower portions of windows to prevent being seen from the outside.

3- If you are fortunate to receive that Plasma TV, electronics, jewelry etc, do not place the box or shipping carton in the yard recycle bins. Criminals will be patrolling neighborhoods looking for indicators. To be safe, take to a neighborhood recycling location.

4- As packages are being delivered, make arrangement to be picked up ASAP by a neighbor or family member or make arrangements to have the package shipped elsewhere or require a delivery signature. Criminals will also patrol neighborhoods looking for deliveries left on porches. Criminals have also been known to follow delivery trucks looking for the packages left on porches. That is also a good indicator that the resident is not at home and tempting to a burglar.
