
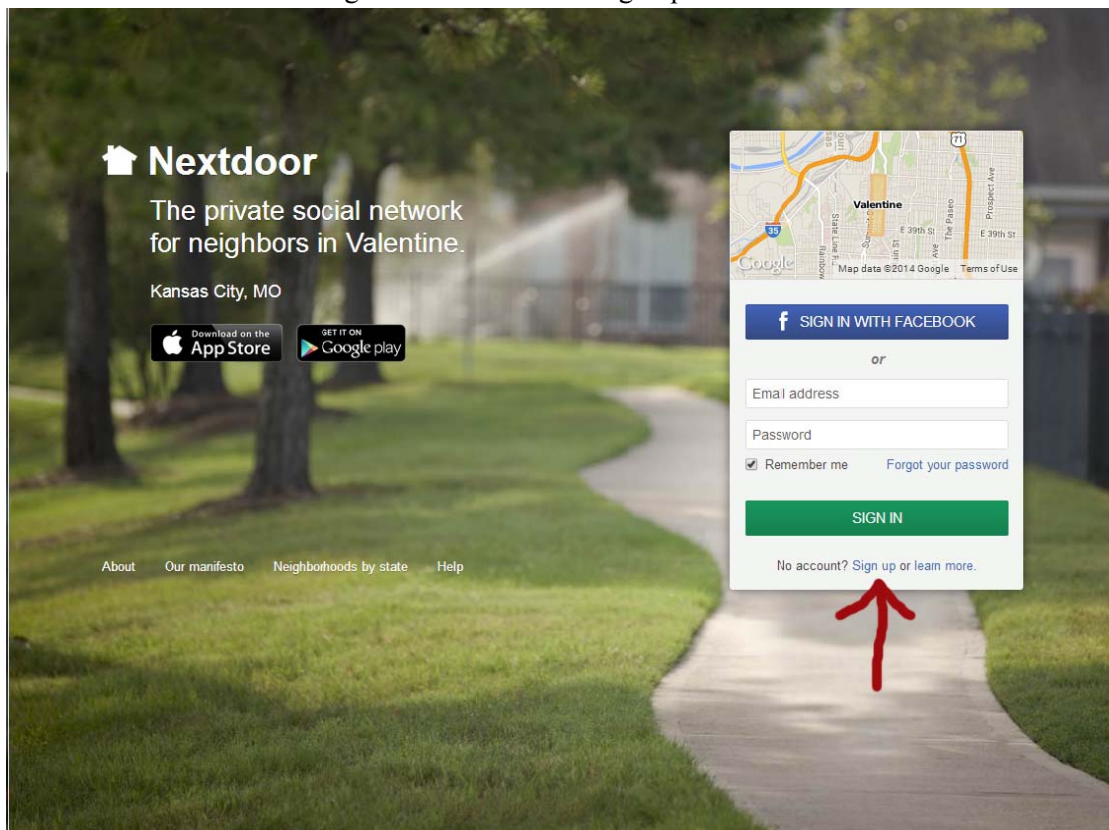


Nextdoor VALENTINE

TO BECOME A MEMBER OF NEXTDOOR VALENTINE:





3. Fill out the information and follow the Nextdoor instructions.


TO CHANGE YOUR ACCOUNT PREFERENCES:
