

Meeting on Request for Short-Term Rental at 3608 Jefferson

The owner of the home at 3608 Jefferson has requested a meeting with the Valentine Neighborhood to request our approval to use the home as a short-term rental. Under Kansas City rules, a property owner can ask for a special use permit if that owner does not

obtain the approval from 55 percent of adjacent property owners to operate the short-term rental.

After meeting with the neighborhood, the owner will need to appear before the city Plan Commission, which will make a recommendation on whether or not the permit should be issued. That recommendation then goes to the Board of Zoning Adjustment (BZA) which makes the final decision.

At the meeting on April 26 at 6:30 p.m., the property owner, Jordan Grove, will have 10 minutes to present his argument for why the special use permit should be granted. Those VNA members who want to have input into the decision will then discuss the issue and take a vote. Based upon that vote, the neighborhood will testify at the hearings before the Plan Commission and the BZA.

The meeting will be held at Penn Valley at our regular meeting location just before the general meeting on August 26.

Help Us Plan for the Future of the Valentine Triangle



Our Neighborhood Association is responsible for the planting and upkeep of the traffic triangle at the intersection of Southwest Trafficway and Valentine Road. Volunteers from the neighborhood have for many years trimmed the trees, planted flowers and kept the triangle looking its best. Last year, the Valentine board submitted a grant proposal to put in a water supply on the island so that volunteers would not have to haul buckets of water. Now it has been suggested that another option would be to plant the triangle with native plants that would not require such frequent watering. We want to give everyone who has an interest in the triangle a

Valentine To Participate in June 10 Yard Sales

Several Midtown neighborhoods are joining together again this year for a big day of yard sales. At our April 26 general meeting, we'll discuss plans for the yard sale and hear what you can do to participate.

Board Seeking Approval for Investment

The Valentine neighborhood has some savings in the bank, and the board is proposing to invest some of it to take advantage of good interest rates right now. At the April 26 meeting, the board will propose investing up to \$2500 a quarter for up to four quarters. The membership will be asked to vote on this proposal.

KC Water Public Meeting: Water Main Replacement on Broadway from 31st to 39th

The Kansas City Water Department will be replacing almost two miles of water main along Broadway beginning in May and lasting through February of 2024. The city says this is part of a comprehensive program to improve service and provide sustainable water service for the future. Some water mains that are being replaced are more than a century old. According to the water department, streets or traffic lanes may be temporarily closed, but business owners and residents will always be able to drive to their property. Other expected issues along Broadway include:

- Large equipment will create noise and dust, which will be controlled.
- Water service will be shut off for brief periods. Property owners will get advance notice.
- If your water meter is inside, the city will move it outside.

 Street, curbs, driveways and sidewalks will be restored and the city will restore lawns during planting season.

If you have detailed questions, there is a public meeting set for Tuesday, April 18 where you can get answers. The meeting will be held at MidtownKC Now at 3931 Main Street (enter from the parking lot at the rear of the building between 39th and 40th on Walnut).
